

# The Hand/Stick Game

## How to Play

1. Two people or 2 teams are needed to play.
2. Begin the game with deciding who (team) will be the hider and who (team) will be the pointer.
3. Ten sticks are divided between the 2 players (team).
4. Among the 4 bones, the hiding player (team) will hide the bones in their hands (one marked, one plain).
5. The pointer (team) guesses which hand the plain bone is in and can point to the location.
6. The winner (team) is the one who wins the sticks with correct guesses of the

## What They Learn

1. Blackfoot culture: engaging with traditional ways of learning skills.

3. Working Memory and Monitoring: by remembering and monitoring cues in body language of the hider.
