

Hoop and Arrow



How to Play

- At the start line, a thrower will assemble the hoops to be thrown down the course.
- 2. Participants line up along the length and toward the end of the course where the hoops will roll.
- 3. Each player will be given arrows or sticks to throw at the hoops.
- Determine a points system for the hoops chosen to play with (ie. Decorated beads).
- 5. As the thrower throws the hoop down to roll along the course, the players throw sticks or arrows to the rolling target (hoop)
- 6. The player who hits the hoop with the most points wins.

What They Learn

- Blackfoot culture: engaging with traditional ways of learning skills.
- Working Memory: to develop accurate hand-eye coordination to hit a moving target.
- 3. Inhibition: by attending and calculating an appropriate time to throw the arrow or stick.
- Emotional Control: by accepting and correcting mistakes and/or losses of the game with respect.



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
